The CDA 81st Annual Conference now invites abstract submissions from CDA Members for consideration in the conference program. Abstract submissions will be accepted in online or manual format.

Abstract submissions will be reviewed for presentation in one of two formats and submitters should indicate their preference.

- Oral plenary presentation
- Poster presentation

ABSTRACT TOPICS

All abstracts submitted must address one of the conference topics for inclusion in the program. When submitting an abstract, please select the topic that your abstract applies to from the list noted below.

*Medical Student Presentations must be sponsored by a CDA member who is registered and present at the conference.

Below is a list of the abstract presentation themes:

1. Diagnosis
2. Therapeutics
3. Surgical Dermatology
4. Cosmetic Dermatology
5. Dermatopathology
6. Contact Dermatitis
7. Pediatric Dermatology

The submission deadline is Friday, January 13, 2006. Notice of adjudication will be provided by Monday, February 13, 2006. Initial correspondence will be addressed to the submitting author. Unless requested otherwise, after acceptance, correspondence will be directed to the designated presenting author. Oral presentations will take place in the plenary and concurrent sessions throughout the meeting days. Posters will be displayed for one full day (TBC) during the meeting to enable delegates to view the information at their leisure. In addition, poster presenters will have dedicated time scheduled to host their posters. Full presentation guidelines will be sent with acceptance notices. Registration for the conference is a condition of acceptance.

Awards will be presented for the best presentation by a Resident or Trainee.

Submission constitutes your consent to publication of the abstract.

Confirmation of registration must be received by Friday, April 7, 2006 in order for the abstract to be accepted and included in the Final Program.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS SUBMITTED ONLINE

An acknowledgment of receipt of the abstract(s) will be sent automatically to the submitting author by email upon completion of the online submission.

Abstracts may be prepared in either French or English.
Abstracts will be published in the language of submission.

We strongly recommend that abstracts be submitted electronically, through the conference website at www.dermatology.ca. Please go to the CDA 81st Annual Conference link and Submit an Abstract section. Prior to adjudication, abstracts that are submitted online allow the presenter to modify the submission until the closing date of January 13, 2006. Those abstracts that are selected for poster or oral presentations will be reproduced exactly as submitted and substitutions will not be permitted, so be sure to proofread your abstract very carefully before submitting. Prepare your abstract in word-processing software such as MS Word, WordPerfect, or a text editor such as MS Write. Do not use presentation software such as PowerPoint. Please limit your abstract to no more than 300 words and limit the number of co-authors to no more than 10. Each abstract should have three paragraphs (Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusions). Please do not include graphics or photographs in your abstract.

SUBMITTING AN ABSTRACT MANUALLY

CD Rom or Disk

If you cannot submit through the website, please use the following guidelines and save your abstract onto a floppy disk or CD-Rom, in either Word or WordPerfect, and mail the disk and a hard copy no later than Monday, January 2, 2006 to the address listed below.

Hard Copy

Be sure to proofread your abstract very carefully before submitting. The presenting author's name should be typed in full, and indicate full contact information, organization, address, telephone, fax and email. Contributing author's (s') names should be typed in full, followed by their organization only. Do NOT include any graphics or slides. Indicate the session topic for which you are submitting (e.g. Diagnosis). There is a 300-word maximum for the abstract text. All additional words will be deleted.
